

Reminders for In-person Worship Service

Members who wish to attend in-person worship services are doing so at their own risk and freely accept the requirements being put in place as described below. For those of you who are uncertain about attending, please stay home and continue to worship with us on-line, until such time as you are certain and comfortable in gathering together.

- Facemasks are a minimum requirement and will be available at the entrance if you forget yours.
- Physical distancing of 6 feet or more.
- Attendees will be seated from front to back of sanctuary and will exit from back to front at the conclusion of worship service.
- No gathering in the narthex, entrance or hall before or after the worship service.
- The guidelines state that singing be prohibited even when wearing face coverings. A small group of people leading worship will sing during the service, but the members in attendance seated in the pews are discouraged from singing even with their masks on.
- Bulletins will be printed and placed on tables with the single serve communion cups and offering plates. These tables will also have hand sanitizer available.

We understand that there are strong and varying emotions about the impact of gathering for in-person worship services and the safety precautions put in place in order to be faithful stewards of one another's health. If you have any questions or concerns you are encouraged to contact your elder, Pastor, or Carrie.
