AUGUST MISSION OF THE MONTH



Sojourner Truth was established in 1997 and is a ministry of hope & help for homeless women and children, sponsored by the Poor Handmaids of Jesus Christ.

Sojourner Truth House (STH) helps, through hospitality, advocacy, integrative services & collaboration. STH helps participants by improving their quality of life & that of the community in a safe & trusting environment.

STH also provides a housing search, laundry facility, transportation to interviews & medical appointments, plus food & clothing to their clients. The clients will receive these services for one month, & women & children will be placed in affordable housing, with the goal of getting them to the next level of self-sufficiency.

With your help, STH served more than 200 women & children in 2019.

In Christ, Sandra Ruban Mission Board Chairman Update from GLC Leadership,

GLC Leadership continues to monitor COVID-19 in our state and across the nation. We are receiving guidance and input from ELCA leadership, Federal/State agencies, and local updates. Service restrictions and precautions needed for in-person worship services are described below. These precautions are considered necessary given our understanding of the risks associated with COVID-19 exposure.

In-person Worship:

Only one entrance – the West entrance at the parking lot – will be used for entry to the worship service. The door attendant will take individuals temperatures as they enter the building as well as hand out masks and/or gloves to anyone attending that may need them. **NOTE:** Masks are required. Gloves are optional. Signs or floor markings will be put down to provide visual references of the 6' distance requirement.

Singing during services:

The guidelines state that singing should be prohibited for the time being, even when wearing face coverings. 2-3 members assisting in leading the worship service will sing during the service. The congregation in attendance, seated in the pews are discouraged from singing even with their masks on.

Hymnals, cushions, other items kept in pews have been removed:

The sanctuary has been stripped of all written materials and cushions to better protect our members and to facilitate the cleaning process. A deep cleaning of the Entry Hall, Narthex, Sanctuary and Restroom areas will be done weekly.

Paper Bulletins:

Bulletins will be printed and placed on tables with the all-in-one communion cups and offering plates. These tables will also have hand sanitizer stations on them.

Seating arrangements:

There will be markings and signs identifying seating that will be used for services, and to prevent members from sitting in pews designated to remain empty for physical distancing requirements. The Ushers will coordinate seating and limit gathering in the Narthex both before and after service and will also be wearing face masks.

After Communion, the Ushers will proceed down the aisles with bowls for members to discard their used communion cups.

When the service has concluded the Ushers will direct the exodus from church starting with members seated in back while maintaining the appropriate physical distancing.

Rummage Sale Update

The annual rummage sale has been put on hold until the Coronavirus numbers are much more manageable and we are able to hold a sale that is safe for all of our workers and for those that come to shop for treasures.

The proceeds from the sale have gone into the Fellowship account over the last few years and have then been shared with the Prayer Garden and GLCW. Fellowship purchases all of the paper/plastic goods that are used in the kitchen for most events and during the past 2 years, has been preparing meals for the Hammond City Rescue Mission Homeless Shelter and paying for the groceries from proceeds from the rummage sale. Those funds are beginning to run very low and are in need of replenishing until we can hold a sale.

The average meal served costs approximately \$150.00. We mix up our menu, but one that is often made is 20 lbs. meatloaf, 25 lbs. mashed potatoes with gravy, beans or corn, salad, cupcakes or cookies, 48 water bottles and 48 cans of pop.

If you would like to help support this mission, please make a donation in any amount to GLC Fellowship and mark "Homeless Shelter" in the memo. We have been asked several times to take an extra week when no volunteers are on the calendar to prepare meals for the men and enjoy doing so. Any financial support received will be greatly appreciated.
