# The Griffith Lutheran Church Mission Of The Month: SAFECHR ~ Ashley's House

The July mission is a new one to our Church, which is SAFE Coalition for Human Rights.

SAFECHR was founded by Dr. Kalyani Gopal, a Munster IN psychologist, when she became aware of children being sex trafficked, which can begin as early as 8 months old & older children that are frequently groomed on the internet, to run away from home.

Dr. Gopal, with her team of executives, ministers, social workers & fellow doctors, founded Ashley's House, which houses youth that have been traumatized by being victims of sexual trafficking.

Ashley's House's mission is to help children which most times are medically, psychologically & behaviorally fragile, to learn about care, warmth & to teach the parents how to fully care for their children, after they are reunited.


