The mission of No Child Hungry is to provide a more stable solution to local children who rely on the food received in school to feed them through the weekend.



No Child Hungry works to provide children with "Buddy Bags" to offset weekends and extended school breaks.

The Buddy Bags offer shelf-stable foods that feed the children a breakfast, lunch, dinner, and healthy snacks that will sustain them through the weekend.

No Child Hungry works through local schools to keep the needs of food insecurity anonymous by asking for the number of children, not names, so the families' privacy will be maintained.

There is no cost to the families who receive the Buddy Bag in Lake and Porter counties.



The GLC provides a homecooked meal prepared by the Fellowship Committee twice a month for the Hammond City Rescue Mission.


Meals include; entrée, sides, beverage and dessert.

School Supplies

This year the GLCW will be collecting school supplies to make School Kits for Lutheran World Relief. We will also provide any extra supplies to Longfellow New Tech Elementary in Calumet Township.

Lutheran World Relief provides School Kits to students impacted by natural disasters in the US as well as in other parts of the world.

The GLCW will be collecting the supplies until mid-August. The items for the school kits must not have any religious or national symbols on them. Each kit will contain the same items.

The items needed for each kit are:

- 4 -70 sheet notebooks (wide ruled or college ruled)
- 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
- 1 pencil sharpener
- 1 pair of blunt scissors
- 5 unsharpened #2 pencils
- 5 black or blue pens (no gel pens)
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1-2 1/2 inch eraser

If you wish to provide supplies for Longfellow, they can use the same items as above. In addition, they need glue sticks and bottles of glue, pencil boxes, dry erase markers and looseleaf paper. They also appreciate boxes of Kleenex.

If you would prefer to give a monetary donation it will be used to buy supplies still needed and to cover the cost of postage for shipping the School Kits.

Thank you so much for helping us help children in need.
