

Good morning!

Our pastoral intern, Miriam has finished her studies and has been approved for candidacy as a rostered minister in the ELCA. As she has graduated but has not yet been ordained there was a gray area in regards to her role here at GLC during the next few months. So Pastor Dan Forehand, Assistant to the Bishop, Indiana/Kentucky Synod, met with the Congregational Council along with our Call committee chair, Scott Muffett, Miriam and Pastor Scales to discuss the plan laid out by Bishop Curry of the Metro Chicago Synod and our own Bishop Gafkjen.

Miriam has been designated a Synod Authorized Minister (SAM) which will allow her to stay with us in that role and also fulfill the work requirements related to her Visa. Being a SAM, Miriam has the ability to be responsible for all services of worship (including blessing of the elements), attend all meetings, make visits and attend to any crisis needs of our congregation. Miriam will continue to have office hours, visit the homebound, preach and preside alongside Pastor Scales and perform other duties as needed on a full-time basis. Miriam will officially begin this position on June 1st, once she returns from her well-deserved vacation time spent with family. We are grateful for Miriam and the time and dedication she has given to our church over the past two years and we look forward to what the future may bring.
