

The purpose of Shop with a Cop is to foster positive relationships with area youth and the Griffith police officers.


Children are selected each year, during the end of the year holiday season to shop at a local store to purchase gifts for members of their immediate family.

Each child is given a small amount of money to spend, normally \$50.00 to \$100.00 depending on the size of the child's immediate family. Approximately 1-2 children are matched with an officer, who will escort the child around the store to select appropriate gifts for each family member.

After shopping the children are given lunch, wrap their gifts & visit with the officers.

Shop with a Cop is a annual signature program for the Griffith Police Department, that Griffith Lutheran Church has supported for many years.


Choir Members Welcome!


