

For the past few weeks, I have been going to cardiac rehab at nine each morning. At one point, I am sitting at a sit-down bicycle type of exercise equipment and usually sit next to the same person. So, we have been having conversations. She is a Lutheran and attends church in Portage. She's mentioned how they no longer have children in attendance, or families. She said that most of those who attend or are members who look like her and she is probably around 80 years old. This seems to be more usual than unusual in churches. She and I talked about how some churches are thriving with families, young people, and children, but most, it seems are not.

There have been all kinds of articles written about how churches can bounce back after the "pandemic", but most agree that churches were not thriving before the pandemic. Is this a "phase" and one day churches will be back in the mainstream, or is this the future, where churches and attending church is almost an afterthought. Only time will tell, probably no matter how hard we try to "bring them in", to quote an old hymn.

Regardless, God does not change. God gave us Jesus, who through the Holy Spirit is with us, regardless. We go to God with our petitions, our wants, our needs, our thanksgivings. We ask God to direct the path and mission of our church and other churches. We are here for the mission of spreading the news about Jesus and His salvation and His love for us all and we will continue to spread the love and salvation of Jesus, whether we are large or whether or are small.




The Griffith Lutheran Church Mission Of The Month: VNA of NW Indiana

Class led by Dennis Robbins - A study on Psalm 23. There is a book and study guide that will be provided for the class.



BBQ/CAR SHOW

Thank you to ALL that helped with the annual BBQ/Car Show. We had an awesome turnout this year. We fed approximately 237 individuals! We had 76 cars registered for the show, with 86 on display for people to view!

We sold \$547.00 in Quilt Raffle Tickets, which will all be going to the Bound With Love Quilt group for expenses. The Quilt was won by Debbie Thinnes (one of our quilters), second place (6 quilted placemats) went to Nina Miller, third (quilted table runner) to Pam Przybylowski, fourth (6 quilted placemats) to Carrie C. And 5th (4 quilted mug rugs) to Jaime from Hammond.

We took in \$795.75 from the food donation box and \$1,140.00 from the Car Show, for a total of \$1,935.75. Our expenses for both the BBQ and Car Show were \$1,477.83. We took in \$457.92 over what we spent. This money will continue to be used to feed the Men's Shelter in Hammond. We also had a \$250.00 Thrivent grant which was obtained by Karen Slager to use for expenses of the car show.
